More than one hundred complete chapters and

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subsections are translated, not to mention shorter passages that help put the longer discussions in context. There are detailed indices of sources, Koranic verses and hadiths. The book's index of technical terminology will be an indispensable reference for all those wishing to delve more deeply into

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the use of language in Islamic thought in general and Sufism in particular.

1865, the Confederacy  
had collapsed, and its  
armed forces had

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ceased to exist. In the spring of 1865, the U.S. Army faced the unprecedented task of occupying eleven conquered Southern states and administering "Reconstruction"-the process by which the former rebellious states would be restored to the Union.

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But a rapid demobilization of the Army placed the remaining occupation troops at a disadvantage almost from the start. This brochure traces the Army's law enforcement, stability, and peacekeeping roles in the South from May 1865 to the

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end of Reconstruction  
in 1877, marking a  
unique period in  
American history.  
During that time, the  
Southern states  
remained under  
military occupation,  
and for several years,  
they were also ruled  
by military  
government. Veteran  
Army commanders

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such as Philip H. Sheridan, John M. Schofield, Daniel E. Sickles, Edward R. S. Canby, and Winfield S. Hancock may have found the work of Reconstruction less dangerous than fighting the Civil War had been, but they also found it no less challenging.

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From the late Thomas Bernhard, arguably Austria's most influential novelist of the postwar period, and one of the greatest artists in all twentieth-century literature in the German language, his magnum opus. Extinction, Bernhard's last work of fiction, takes the form of the

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autobiographical  
testimony of Franz-  
Josef Murau, the  
intellectual black  
sheep of a powerful  
Austrian land-owning  
family. Murau lives in  
Rome in self-imposed  
exile from his family,  
surrounded by a  
coterie of artistic and  
intellectual friends.

On returning from his

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sister's wedding to the "wine-cork manufacturer" on the family estate of Wolfsegg, having resolved never to go home again, Murau receives a telegram informing him of the death of his parents and brother in a car crash. Not only must he now go back, he

must do so as the  
master of Wolfsegg.  
And he must decide  
its fate. Divided into  
two halves, Extinction  
explores Murau's rush  
of memories of  
Wolfsegg as he stands  
at his Roman window  
considering the fateful  
telegram, in  
counterpoint to his  
return to Wolfsegg

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and the preparations  
for the funeral itself.

extraordinary literary
