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The law of agency is the law of delegation—i.e., the legal principles that govern the ability of one person (the principal) to have another person (the agent) act on his behalf. Basic agency relationships underlie virtually all commercial dealings in the modern world.

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Agency: An Overview. Agency law is concerned with any "principal"- "agent" relationship; a relationship in which one person has legal authority to act for another. Such relationships arise from explicit appointment, or by implication.

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
