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Systemic functional linguistics is the study of the relationship between language and its functions in social

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settings. Also known as SFL, systemic functional grammar, Hallidayan linguistics, and systemic linguistics . Three strata make up the linguistic system in SFL: meaning (semantics), sound (phonology), and wording or lexicogrammar (syntax, morphology, and lexis).
