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are traded by networks of dedicated collectors worldwide. Serious fans and collectors have been known to spend as much as \$225 for an original, scratchy vinyl recording

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of bands like Deep Purple and the Grateful Dead dating back to the early seventies. The rarest of all are akin to valuable paintings as far as collectors and traders are

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concerned.
