B.C 356-306), to the enactment about prices, which occurs in Laws xi., viz that the same goods should not be offered at two prices on the same day (Ou gegone kreiton nomothetes tou plousiou Aristonikou tithesi gar nuni nomon, ton ichthuopolon otis an polon tini ichthun upotimesas apodot elatontos es eipe times, eis to desmoterion euthus apagessthai touton, ina dedoikotes tes axias agapasin, e tes esperas saprous apantas apopherosin okade.
