Registered nurses perform some aspects of both noninvasive and invasive diagnostic tests such as an ECG and a blood sample for blood glucose testing, for example. 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Exercise or Stress Testing Various protocols used to evaluate effect of exercise tolerance on cardiovascular function. A common procedure uses 3-minute stages at set speeds and elevation of the treadmill belt. Patient can exercise to either predicted peak HR or to peak exercise tolerance at which the time the test is terminated.
