Institutes of the Christian Religion is John Calvin's original work of systematic theology. Throughout the past two years, Trans World Airlines, Midway Airlines, and R.H. Macy Company, as well as over 46,000 other corporations, have filed petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code. Of the firms that have filed Chapter 11 reorganization petitions, over eighty percent will never reorganize successfully and will not avoid a subsequent conversion to a Chapter 7 liquidation proceeding. This Article posits a two-part revision to the present Chapter 11 system: (1) replacing corporate managers acting as debtors in possession with trustees; and (2) establishing a methodology to guide these new decision makers in determining whether a reorganization or a liquidation is the proper course of action in a given case.
