However, cognition/thinking-development, in terms of one's being creative, revolves around using imagination and being inventive, which in turn requires thinking about what one is thinking — meta-cognition. Defining Creativity. At one time, creativity was considered to be the function of the right brain hemisphere.

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We propose that the nature of the relationship between creativity and the distance of an individual’s expertise from a knowledge domain depends on his or her cognitive processes of problem solving (i.e., cognitive-search effort and cognitive-search variation).

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Creativity is a vast construct, seemingly intractable to scientific inquiry—perhaps due to the vague concepts applied to the field of research. One attempt to limit the purview of creative cognition formulates the construct in terms of evolutionary constraints, namely that of blind variation and selective retention (BVSR).

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
