Incident to Self-Service Tool. The purpose of the "Incident to" self-service tool is to assist providers with understanding the CMS Part B "incident-to" requirements and to apply the rules to their individual given patient/provider circumstances and to understand documentation requirements.

A decision tree helps companies to know more information about their decision-making processes. It helps them to have a preview of a chance event outcome and how it can affect their operations.

The Incident Decision Tree supports the aim of creating an open culture, where employees feel able to report patient safety incidents without undue fear of the consequences. The tool comprises an algorithm with accompanying guidelines and poses a series of structured questions to help managers decide whether suspension is essential or whether alternatives might be feasible.

The Incident Decision Tree: Guidelines for Action ...

A decision tree takes you step-by-step through a questionnaire. Based on your answers, the decision tree completes part of the form for a new incident request record. Each element in the decision tree displays a list of items. Your final selection completes part of the incident. Decision trees are built by a manager or administrator at your company.

The decision tree consists of rectangles, big circles, small circles, and arrows. Each decision, represented by a rectangle can lead to one or more outcomes, represented by big circles. An outcome may require further decisions, leading to further outcomes and so on.
