En los últimos años, se han dado cambios estructurales en la forma de impartir clases en los distintos niveles educativos. Hasta hace algunos años, los docentes solamente utilizaban gis y borrador para impartir una cátedra y algunos se apoyaban también en acetatos. En algunos casos, dependiendo de la estrategia del docente, los alumnos deben copiar dicha información, o a manera de apoyo se les distribuye los archivos digitales de diversas formas, desde una impresión de las diapositivas, hasta el envío de éstas por correo electrónico. Por otro lado, el docente intercambia documentos y tareas por medio de su cuenta de correo electrónico, y es cuando suelen surgir una serie de problemas los cuales se describen más adelante, pero el punto principal es que se complica la administración de esta información.

Este manual práctico explica, partiendo desde cero, cómo utilizar la herramienta 'Taller' de MOODLE para que los alumnos se corrijan entre sí los ejercicios. De esta forma aprenden dos veces: la primera mientras preparan la tarea que les pedimos y la segunda al revisar las de los demás mediante rúbricas-guía. El ordenador no sólo calculará automáticamente la nota asignada por los pares, sino que -más importante aún- evaluará y calificará también a cada evaluador por esa labor de

detección de errores y méritos ajenos. Así, el propio grupo se ve obligado a autocontrolarse y el modelo deviene escalable, al ser más fiable precisamente cuantos más estudiantes participen y mayor sea la muestra. Además de desgranar paso a paso el funcionamiento detallado de la herramienta, con un centenar de ilustraciones y explicaciones prácticas, el libro ofrece trucos y consejos prácticos derivados de la experiencia sobre el terreno de su autor, también profesor.
