Method. In the first part of a two-stage enquiry, a 28-item scale was constructed to examine the components of challenging behaviour. Following a simple factor analysis this was developed further to create a new short scale, the Problem Behaviour Checklist (PBCL).

### **The Problem Behaviour Checklist: short scale to assess ...**

The RBPC is used to rate problem behaviors observed in adolescents and young children ages 5-18 years. The six RBPC subscales measure Conduct Disorder, Socialised Aggression, Attention Problems-Immaturity, Anxiety-Withdrawal, Psychotic Behaviour, and Motor Tension-Excess. The Child Problem Behavior Checklist is a 24-item measure that was generated from the Child Behavior Checklist (Achenbach & Edelbrock, 1981), the Revised Behavior Problem Checklist (Quay & Peterson, 1987) and other behavior checklists. Items tap child externalizing behavior problems.

### **Child Problem Behavior Checklist**

Severity. 0 No injury Does not appear to cause pain or tissue damage to other person. 1 Minor injury Has caused superficial scratching or reddening of the other person's skin (e.g. light slaps/hits, gentle pushes, hair pulling without force). 2 Moderate injury Has caused moderate tissue damage to other person (e.g. bites/kicks/hits 3 Serious injury Has caused serious tissue damage (e.g. cuts, wounds, requires stitching). 4 Very serious injury Has caused very serious ...
