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Measuring Executive Function Gains in Formal and Informal ...

The purpose of the Executive Function Mapping Project Measures Compendium is to provide information about the range of measures available to assess executive function (EF) and other regulation-related skills. The field of EF and other regulation-related research is broad, rapidly-growing, and encompasses many related but distinct skills and competencies (Jones, Bailey, Barnes, & Partee, 2016).

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Although these propositions of using Rasch Model to establish a common metrics or yardstick in computing specific executive functioning requires more rigorous methodology and cross-validation, this sophisticated statistical technique may serve as a potential tool for researcher to refine the measurement of executive functions in the near future.

Testing a child for executive functioning issues can be tricky. That's because executive function is the management system of the brain, and it involves a wide range of skills. Individual tests may look at a number of areas to pinpoint where the trouble spots are. So there can appear to be overlap between tests in what they measure.

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? Elithorn Maze – designed to measure executive function. Sensitive to moderate to severe but not mild executive functioning deficits. Requires planning, self-monitoring and inhibitory control. ? Block Design - mild executive functioning effects.

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
