

Molecular Targeted Therapy For Hepatocellular Carcinoma Bench To Bedside 7th Japan Korea Liver Symposium Kyoto

Targeted agents that inhibit receptor tyrosine kinases and their downstream signal mediators, angiogenesis, and immunomodulators have been developed and clinically investigated. Among these targeted agents, the multi-kinase inhibitor sorafenib has become the standard treatment for advanced HCC, though its therapeutic benefit is limited. Treatment of advanced hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC) still confronts great challenges due to high rate of therapeutic resistance. The emergence of systemic treatment with molecular targeted and immune checkpoint therapies has brought novel approaches towards patients with advanced HCC. However, sorafenib, as the first approved systemic treatment in 2007, only increased overall survival by three months in advanced HCC patients. Targeted therapies are being used in advanced HCC patients due to a better survival and less side effects when compared to traditional chemotherapy. Despite numerous studies over subsequent years aimed at developing novel molecular targeted agents, no new drugs have produced positive results to date.

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
