Bioprocess Technology combines concepts and ideas from biology, engineering, materials science, and clinical processes. The industrial use of biological processes utilising living cells or their components to achieve desired substrate transformations is known as bioprocess technology.

Bioprocesses provide several benefits over standard chemical processes, including the need for moderate reaction conditions, increased specificity and efficiency, and the production of renewable by-products (biomass).

Bioprocesses' potential has been broadened and extended thanks to the introduction of recombinant DNA technology.

Bioprocesses are now widely employed in a variety of
