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Strategies for Trading Volatility With Options

Volatility trading can be done three ways (through price, VIX, and options). Volatility trading lets you profit without forecasting the price direction. Implied volatility shows the expected future volatility. Options prices and implied volatility move in the same direction.

Volatility quote trading makes investment decisions based on the volatility of a specific security or market. Volatility can be used in options markets based on the predicted volatility of the contract. The volatility quote trading strategy is an alternative to the general trading styles that uses the bid and ask price to find optimal investments.

Strategy 1 is to sell a call option with lower execution price and higher execution price, and then buy two call options with intermediate execution price; strategy 2 is to sell a put option with lower execution price and higher execution price, and then buy two call options with intermediate execution price.

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
