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Exemptions | Adams County Government

Even if an institution qualifies as a purely public charity, any particular parcel of real estate may not qualify

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for exemption if that parcel is not actually and regularly used for the purposes of the institution. The use of the property is important in establishing its exemption.

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designated 501(c) in the tax code) ?? enjoy the first exemption but not the second one. For instance, your local Chamber of Commerce probably is a 501(c)(6) ?? , which is tax-exempt. Your recreational club may be a 501(c)(7) ?? , which is also tax-exempt. donations and thus can not provide a personal tax exemption to members.

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A charity is exempt from tax on income arising in respect of rents or other receipts from land or property that it holds for charitable purposes insofar as the income is applied for charitable purposes only. This exemption includes, for example, rental income. The exemption does not generally extend to
