The present volume begins with fractions, then rational numbers, then introductory geometry that can make sense of the slope of a line, then an explanation of the correct use of symbols that makes sense of “ variables ” , and finally a systematic treatment of linear equations that explains why the graph of a linear equation in two variables is a straight line and why the usual solution method for simultaneous linear equations “ by substitutions ” is correct. This book should be useful for current and future teachers of K – 12 mathematics, as well as for some high school students and for education professionals.
