An educator's primary focus is to provide the very best educational learning experiences for the students. However, each student has various needs that must be addressed. 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Classroom provision for each Gifted and Talented student is monitored by the Coordinator for Gifted and Talented students as part of the ongoing cycle of lesson observations and work sampling. The Coordinator for Gifted and Talented is to organise one to one mentoring sessions with year 11 Gifted and Talented students who are underperforming.

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Gifted is not an elitist label. Rather it is a term that allows students to be identified for educational services that help meet their exceptional learning needs. Gifted education programmes in schools are elitist. Gifted education programs should be designed so that they help all gifted students.

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Your starting point, if you want to become a gifted students ' teacher, is to complete a bachelor ' s degree, either in a particular subject matter or in elementary or secondary education. By pursuing a degree in something besides teaching, you bring a level of expertise into the classroom that gifted students may benefit from.

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
