Yet with a little imagination, the stay-at-home mom (or dad) can take advantage of the flexible schedule of their life. "When for the first time I decided to make a day-trip with my daughter Angelika to visit a friend living 250 km away, I felt as if I had wings," says Wegner. "Windows of adventure and opportunity opened in front of me. When else in life one has a chance to spontaneously decide on a Tuesday about a day-trip on Wednesday? Probably at retirement?" The book can be read in a chronological order or thumbed through as a reference guide when planning a trip. The book includes a detailed index, a list of internet resources, and a time-line of the trips Angelika has taken with her mother. By comparing Angelika's age with her trips, the reader can get a sense of the possibilities for different trips at different ages.
