Despite decades of research, its pathophysiology still remains an enigma, and virtually all neurotransmitter systems have been implicated in the etiology of this

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disease. Since the discovery of chlorpromazine in 1950, more than 50 different drugs have been developed (1), revolutionizing the treatment of schizophrenia.

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The posterior root section for treatment of spasticity in cerebral palsy and diluted procaine injection near intramuscular nerve for treating hyperactive stretch reflex (Rushworth, 1960) were based on this theory.
