and sea. These
three volumes,
now available

together for the first time in paperback, include all entries made from the time when Camus was still completely unknown in Europe, until he was killed in an automobile accident in 1960,

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at the height of his creative powers. In 1957 he had been awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature. A spiritual and intellectual autobiography, Camus' Notebooks are invariably more concerned with what he felt than

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with what he did. It is intriguing for the reader to watch him seize and develop certain themes and ideas, discard others that at first seemed promising, and explore different types of experience.

have served
Camus as a
practice ground,
the prose is of
superior quality,
which makes a
short spontaneous
vignette or a
moment of
sensuous beauty
